Applicable from 1st October 2022

All energy companies are required to tell their customers about the mix of fuels they use to generate the electricity and the impact this has on the environment. PX Supply Limited (PXSL) publish our Fuel Mix Disclosure each year and the table below shows the fuel mix for the electricity purchased for supply during 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022.
